# UPDATE ON THE LADY CHAPEL

Ever since I have been in the parish, I have been asked on a regular basis to do something about improving the Lady Chapel. Part of this has been a desire expressed by many to have a proper statue of Our Lady in the Chapel in place of the plaque. As we were recently offered the wooden statue of Our Lady which is currently standing in the corner of the Chapel, I thought this would be an opportunity to do something. The statue is by the artist David John, who designed a number of other of the sacred images in the church and is therefore in keeping with the décor in the church.

If it is decided to put the wooden statue in place, then a simple plinth would be built for it to stand upon and the chapel would have to be repainted a pale blue as the wood doesn't work at all against the present background, and the chapel needs repainting anyway. The present plaque would be relocated somewhere and the alterations would be done in such a way as to make it very easy to alter it back again.

If we don't go ahead then the wooden statue would be returned from whence it came. The statue cannot remain in the Chapel with the plaque as it is not appropriate to have more than one image of Our Lady in the Chapel. A number of parishioners have already made known to me their views, some for and some against the change, and I would ask you to continue to do this. *Fr. Peter*
